
Tuition and Fees

2025-26 Academic Year

Tuition \$73,566 (\$36,783 billed each semester)

Includes mandatory activity fee for the year, which covers all activities funded through [CCSGA](#). The activity fee for 2025-26 is \$528.

Full time status = 3 blocks per semester (\$36,783)

Fall semester = 4 blocks offered (3 blocks \$36,783 and 4th block no additional charge)

Spring semester = 4 blocks offered (3 blocks \$36,783 and 4th block no additional charge)

NOTE: Half Block is part of spring semester. If a student is enrolled full time in spring semester, there will be no additional charge for Half Block.

Per block rate = \$12,261. CC does NOT charge by the block but instead charges the semester tuition fee at the beginning of each semester. The semester fee equates to the per block rate multiplied by three.

Housing for fall and spring semesters

Traditional Double Dorm Room Rate = \$9,288 (\$4,644 billed each semester)

Meal Plans for fall and spring semesters

Full meal plan = \$7,376 (\$3,688 billed each semester)

Includes mandatory facilities fee of \$700 for the year, which covers building maintenance and various dining venue expenses.

Apartment meal plan = \$1,192 (\$596 billed each semester) – no mandatory facilities fee added

- All students living on campus are required to have a CC meal plan. Students living in the traditional halls, small houses and language houses are required to have the full meal plan.
- Those living in student apartments, East Campus apartments, fraternities and sororities are required to have the apartment meal plan and may opt for the full meal plan if desired.

- Exceptions to this policy include cottage housing and those students living in off-campus housing; residents in these spaces are not required to purchase meal plans.

CC Student Health Insurance (optional*)

Fall semester coverage (8/1/25 - 12/31/25) = \$2,081 billed in fall semester

Spring semester coverage (1/1/26 - 7/31/26) = \$2,894 billed in spring semester

*CC health insurance is available to all CC students. Students are not required to participate in the college's health insurance plan if they have other health coverage. All students must either ENROLL or WAIVE the health insurance plan every year. Fall semester online enrollment/waiver process is open July 1 through August 31, 2025, at waiver portal.

Failure to complete the online waiver will result in defaulted enrollment in the CC health plan for the semester; a premium charge of \$2,081 (fall semester coverage fee) will be posted to the student's account and will be due September 5, 2025.

Important notes:

1. It may take 7 to 10 days for waivers to be approved by the Student Health Center.
2. CC athletes may also have a sports insurance rider. This is not the same medical insurance coverage and does not exempt any student from completing the enrollment/waiver process.

Students who complete enrollment/waiver for the fall semester DO NOT need to complete the waiver in the spring semester unless they are changing their election for coverage.

Winter starts students and students starting classes in the spring must waive or enroll for spring semester. Failure to complete the online waiver will result in defaulted enrollment in the CC health plan for spring semester; a premium charge of \$2,894 (spring semester coverage fee) will be posted to the student's account and will be due February 6, 2026.

Department/Course Fees

Fees vary. Please contact the department directly to determine if the course has additional expenses/fees.

Miscellaneous Fees

Music lessons - \$550 for 12 private lessons & \$90 for group lessons

Parking - \$300 yearly fee (\$150 one semester only)

Gold Card replacement - \$30

Health Service - fees vary. Contact the Health Center for more information at 719-389-6386.

Athletics - fees vary for club sports and equipment fees.

Traffic fines, library fines, residence hall damage, and broken or not-returned equipment may be charged to the student account - fees vary.

DEPOSITS

Admission Fees and Deposits*

Beginning with students who apply for entry in January 2020 and beyond, we will no longer charge an application fee for undergraduate degree-seeking enrollment. There will still be an application fee in place for summer session pre-college as well as graduate/MAT entry.

For students entering the fall semester 2025-26, a general obligation deposit of \$1,000 is required of both new students and students returning after interrupting college enrollment. This deposit is applied to the first semester invoice. The deposit is forfeited by failure to provide notice of withdrawal by March 1 for the fall semester and November 1 for the spring semester for enrolled students, or after acceptance of admission for new students.
