

## National Public Lands Helps the Wyoming Economy


Greatest proportion of the voters who perceive an economic benefit from national public lands in their state

## Oppose State Takeover of Public Lands

"Some Members of Congress have proposed giving **Wyoming** state government control over national public lands, such as national forests, national monuments, and national wildlife refuges in its borders. The state government would decide the future management of the lands, but state taxpayers would pay all costs, including the cost of maintenance and preventing and fighting wildfires."







Conservation is Important in Candidate Selection



Tied with Montana for greatest proportion of the electorate which identifies as a "conservationist" (71%)

- 72% support presidential authority for National Monument designation
- 76% support treating wildfires as natural disasters in budgeting;
- 74% support continuing investment in LWCF
