

HOW TO APPLY FOR A CC SUMMER BLOCK ABROAD OR AWAY

LEARN WHAT'S AVAILABLE

- Come to the Summer Away Fair in early November
- Speak with the faculty leaders of the program
- Find complete program info on the Global Education website

APPLY!

- The CC Summer blocks away application period in Summit is during Block 4 and Half-Block. Check our website for specific deadline dates!
- You complete one application in Summit to be considered for both admission and financial aid. Aid is limited and programs fill, so apply by the deadline!
- We always recommend applying as early in the window as possible as many faculty use rolling admissions and programs can close before the window does. Aid is always awarded after the window closure date.

CONFIRMATION!

- Once approved for a program, return to Summit to complete required forms and to confirm your spot. Failure to confirm participation can lead to your spot being given to another student.
- Once confirmed, a student can still withdraw by March 1 with no program charges billed to them.

CONFIRMED STUDENTS ARE ADDED TO THE COURSE



Once you confirm your participation in Summit, Global Education will work with the Registrar to add you to the summer course. If you withdraw, you will automatically be dropped from Banner as well.

WHAT TO DO ONCE YOU ARE IN THE PROGRAM

- Retain your GPA above 2.00 to remain eligible
- Avoid disciplinary probations or suspensions
- Expect and respond to faculty leader emails
- Attend all pre-departure orientation meetings
- Confirm that your passport is valid 6 months past the program. If not, apply for a new passport right away. It can take weeks to get a new one.

WHAT IF YOU NEED TO WITHDRAW?



- Return to Summit and click "Request Cancellation" to withdraw
- Withdraw by March 1 to avoid all charges.
- Late withdrawal requires a charge of 25% of the program's fee.
- The charge increases to 75% for any Block 8 or later withdrawal.
