ENVIRONMENT AT THE BALLOT BOX




84% of Arizonans say that issues involving clean water, wildlife, and public lands are important in deciding whether to support an elected public official.

70% think that oil and gas development on national public lands should be stopped or strictly limited, as opposed to expanded.

RECREATION

PROTECTING LAND, WATER & WILDLIFE



79% support a national goal of protecting 30 percent of America's lands and waters by 2030.



82% support creating new national parks, national monuments, national wildlife refuges, and tribal protected areas.

FIRE & DROUGHT CONCERNS

are concerned about more frequent and severe wildfires.

66% think that wildfires in the West are more of a problem than they were 10 years ago.

are concerned about droughts and reduced snowpack.

ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

69% support gradually transitioning to one hundred percent clean, renewable energy over the next ten to fifteen years.

say that there is enough evidence of climate change that action should be taken.
