# MERICANS

#### **ENVIRONMENT AT** THE BALLOT BOX



80% of Native say that **issues** involving clean water, wildlife, and public lands are important in deciding whether to support an elected public official.

#### **ENERGY ON PUBLIC LANDS**

support requiring oil and gas companies to pay for all clean-up and restoration costs after drilling.

# RECREATION



visited national public lands more than twice in the past vear.

80% think that oil and gas development on national public lands should be stopped or strictly limited, as opposed to expanded.

#### **PROTECTING LAND,** WATER & WILDLIFE



**81%** support a national goal of protecting 30 percent of America's lands and waters by 2030.



86% support creating new national parks, national monuments, national wildlife refuges, and tribal protected areas.

## **FIRE & DROUGHT CONCERNS**

**89%** are concerned about more frequent and severe wildfires.

**71%** think that wildfires in the West are more of a problem than they were 10 years ago.

84% are concerned about droughts and reduced snowpack.

## **ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE**

64% support gradually transitioning to one hundred percent clean, renewable energy over the next ten to fifteen years.

**69%** say that there is enough evidence of climate change that action should be taken.
