#### **PROTECTING LAND**, WATER & WILDLIFE



66% support a national goal of protecting 30 percent of America's lands and waters by 2030.



support creating new national parks, national monuments, national wildlife refuges, and tribal protected areas.

## **FIRE & DROUGHT CONCERNS**

76% are concerned about more frequent and severe wildfires.

0% think that wildfires in the West are more of a problem than they were 10 years ago.

84% are concerned about droughts and reduced snowpack.

### **ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE**

49% support gradually transitioning to one hundred percent clean, renewable energy over the next ten to fifteen years.

52% say that there is enough evidence of climate change that action should be taken.

#### **ENVIRONMENT AT** THE BALLOT BOX



**88%** of Wyomingites say that issues involving clean water, wildlife, and public lands are important in deciding whether to support an elected public official.


